Agreed Temporary Orders

On the below date, the Court considered the parties' agreed temporary orders. With the agreement of the parties, the Court orders that, until further order of the Court, the following orders apply to game rooms permitted under the Lubbock County Game Room Ordinance:


1. Defendant shall not enforce Section 3.2(a) of the 2026 Lubbock County Game Room Ordinance against a permitted game room provided that said game room shall not be open to customers before 10:00 am or after 10:00 pm on any day. If, however, a permitted game room is open to customers outside of the hours of 10:00 am to 10:00 pm, said game room will be subject to any penalty or consequence authorized by the 2026 Lubbock County Game Room Ordinance for a violation of the hours of operation provisions thereof.
2. Defendant shall not enforce Section 3.3(d) of the 2026 Lubbock County Game Room Ordinance.

The Court, with the agreement of the parties, waives the requirement of a bond and will schedule this case for trial on the merits by separate order and at a later time.
