### **Eligibility for Public Office (141.001, Texas Election Code)**

- U.S. Citizen
- 18 years of age or older
- No final judgement indicating totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote
- No final felony conviction unless pardoned or released from resulting disabilities
- Resided continuously in the state for 12 months
- Resided continuously in the territory for 6 months.
- Registered voter of the territory

must continue to reside within the City and the applicable District during the term of office.

- Shall not be indebted to the City of Lubbock.
- Shall not hold any public office of emolument.
- Shall not be interested in the profits or emoluments of any contract, job, work or service for the municipality or interested in the sale to the City of any supplies, equipment, material or articles purchased.
- Any member of the City Council shall not have a substantial interest in any public utility operating within the City of Lubbock, nor be in the employ of any person having a substantial interest in any public utility operating within the City of Lubbock. (Substantial interest shall mean substantial interest as defined by the laws of the State of Texas regulating conflicts of interest of officers of municipalities.)
